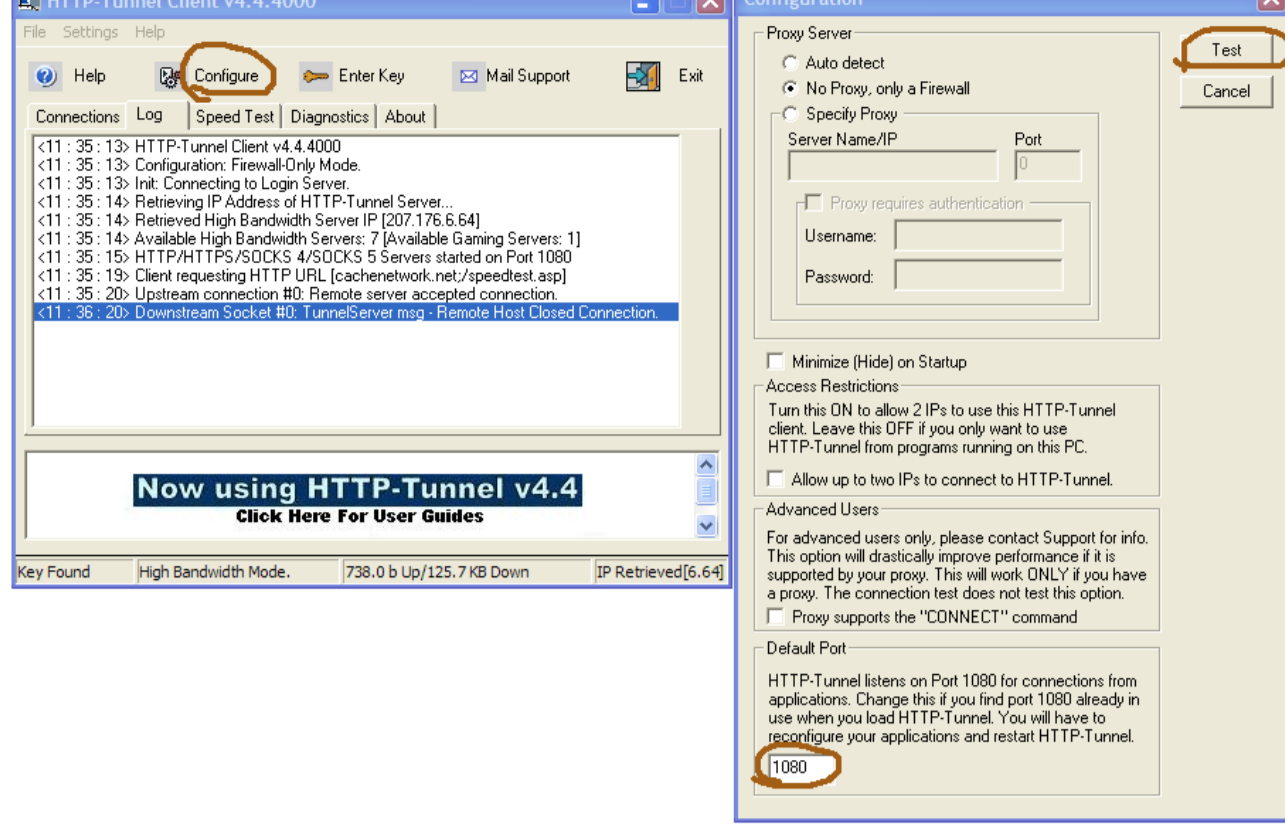


This guide will show you how to configure ICQ to use Http-Tunnel.

Once you have Http-Tunnel installed, run the application, The main window will appear, choose the configure option. There you will be presented with three (3) options.

1. You can Select Auto detect if you want Http-Tunnel to detect your settings.
2. No Proxy, only a firewall if this is appropriate.
3. Specify Proxy, Here you will enter the IP address and Port number of the proxy that you use. If your proxy requires authorization fill in the appropriate fields.

Complete 1 of the 3 options, then click test, the client will bind to port 1080 and localhost by default and connect to the tunnel servers if your settings are correct.



Open ICQ and ' Click ' on main. A pull down menu should appear. Scroll down to ' Options ' and ' Click ' it. The Options window should appear. Scroll down and locate ' Advanced ' and ' Click ' on ' Connection '. The Connection Settings interface should appear. Put a dot in Manual settings. Fill in the fields as in the example below. Where you see HTTP underlined there is a pull down menu. You can choose between HTTP or SOCKS4/5 . Experimenting with these settings may determine which works best for you.
