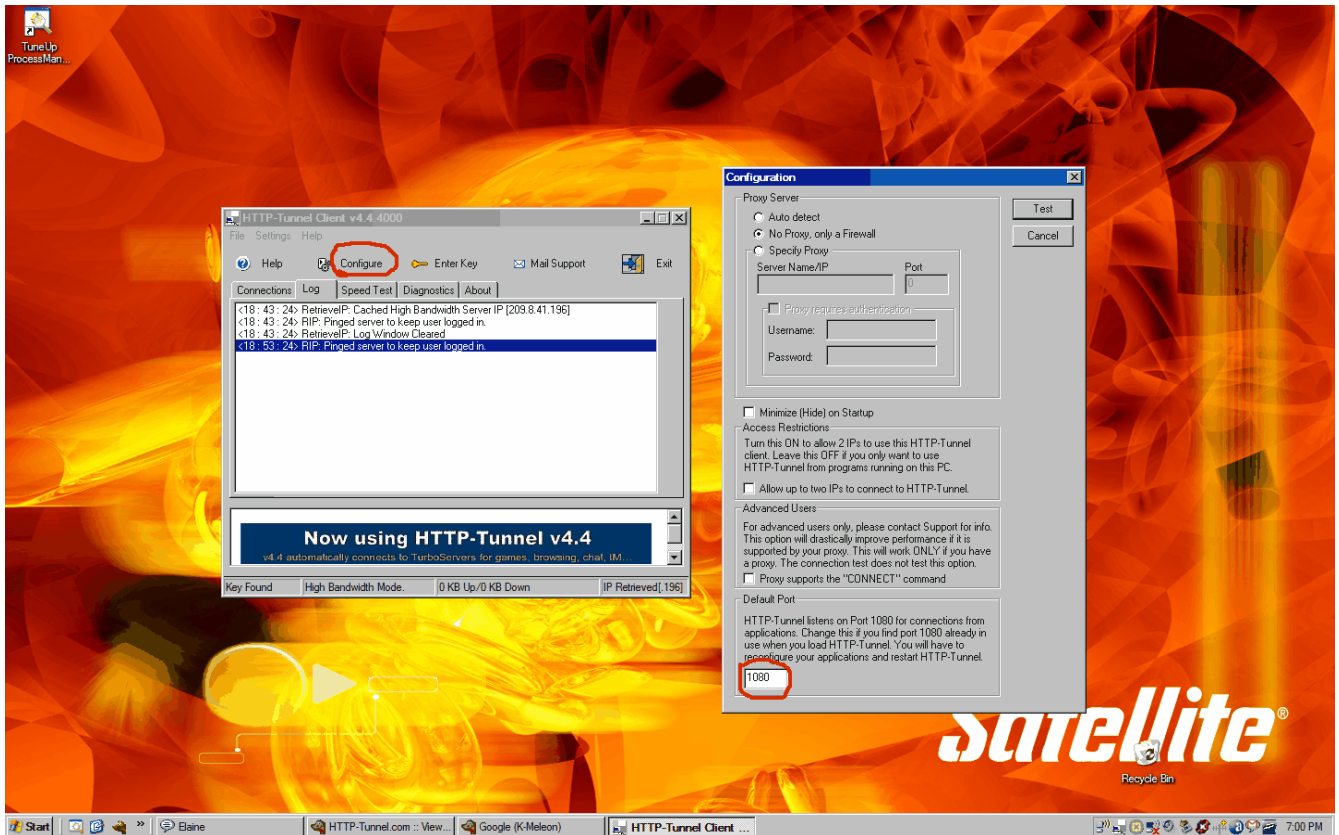


This is the guide to configure Opera Web browser to use with HTTP Tunnel.  
Please note that its only a configuration guide,we do not provide any support related to this specific client.

Once you have Http-Tunnel installed, run the application, The main window will appear, choose the configure option. There you will be presented with three ( 3 ) options.

1. You can Select Auto detect if you want Http-Tunnel to detect your settings.
2. No Proxy, only a firewall if this is appropriate.
3. Specify Proxy, Here you will enter the IP address and Port number of the proxy that you use.

Complete 1 of the 3 options, then click test, the client will bind to port 1080 and localhost by default and connect to the tunnel servers if your settings are correct.



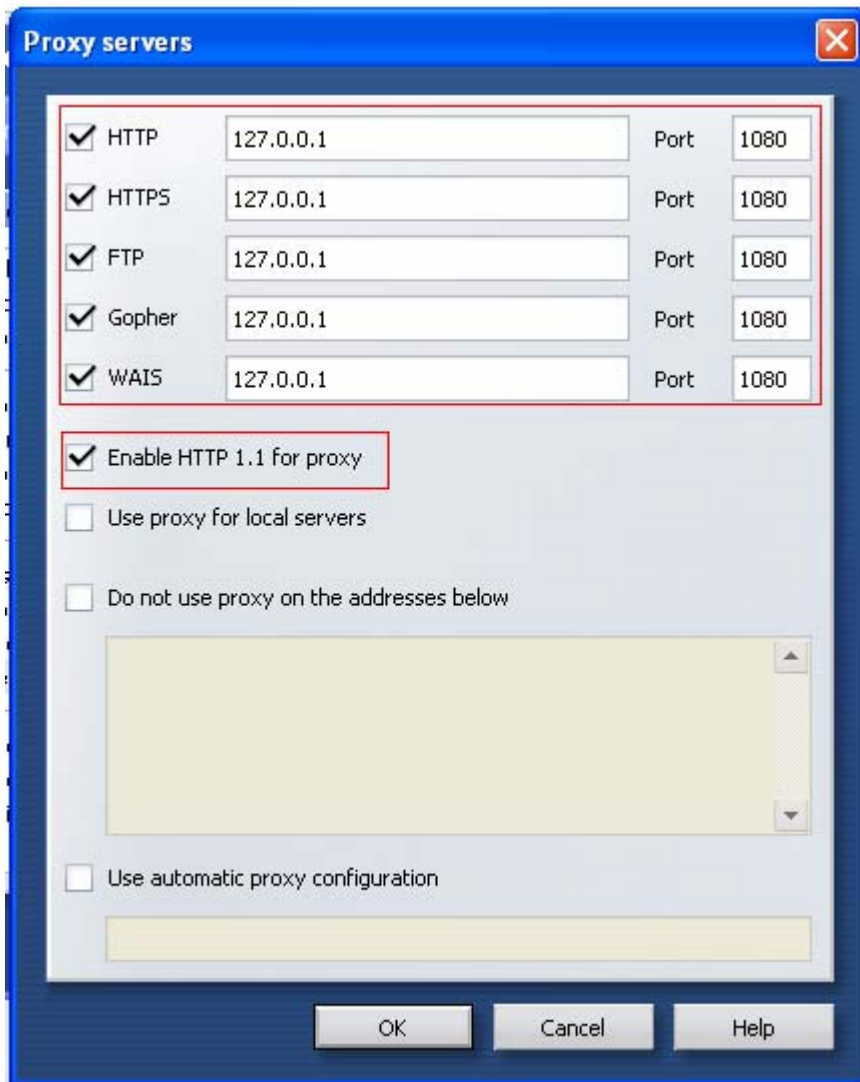
Go to Tools -> Preferences.

Click on Advanced tab and go down to Network option on the Left Hand Side.

Click on Proxy Servers

Enable all the protocols and fill 127.0.0.1 in the field next to it and 1080 for port.

Click on enable HTTP 1.1 for proxy



Click on Ok and you are good to go

You should see it connecting via HTTP Tunnel
