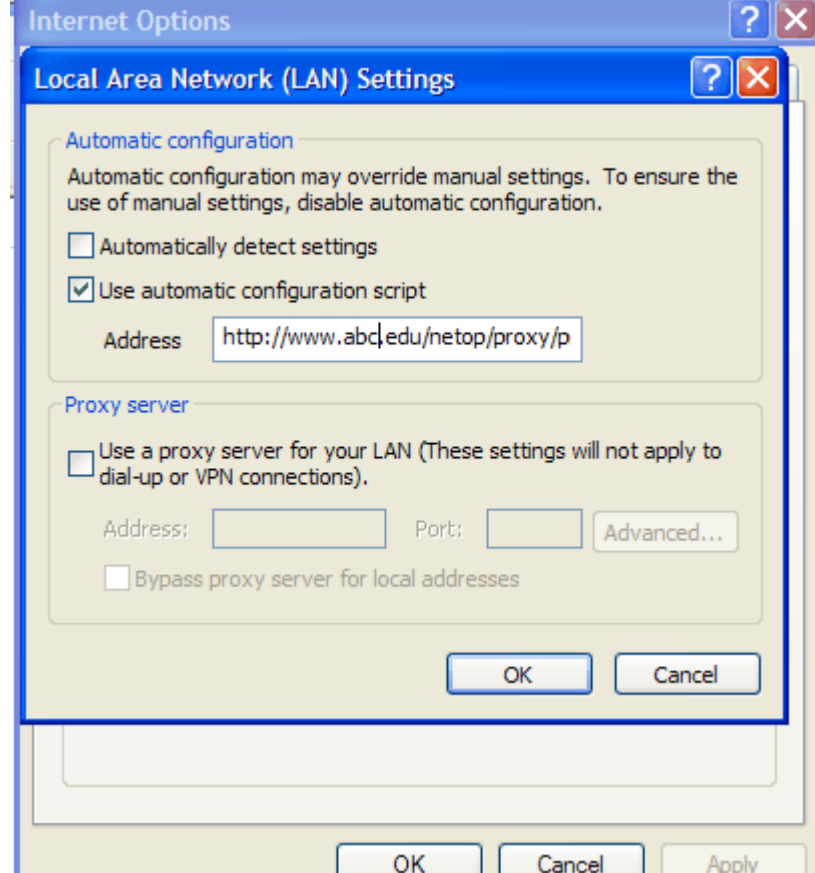
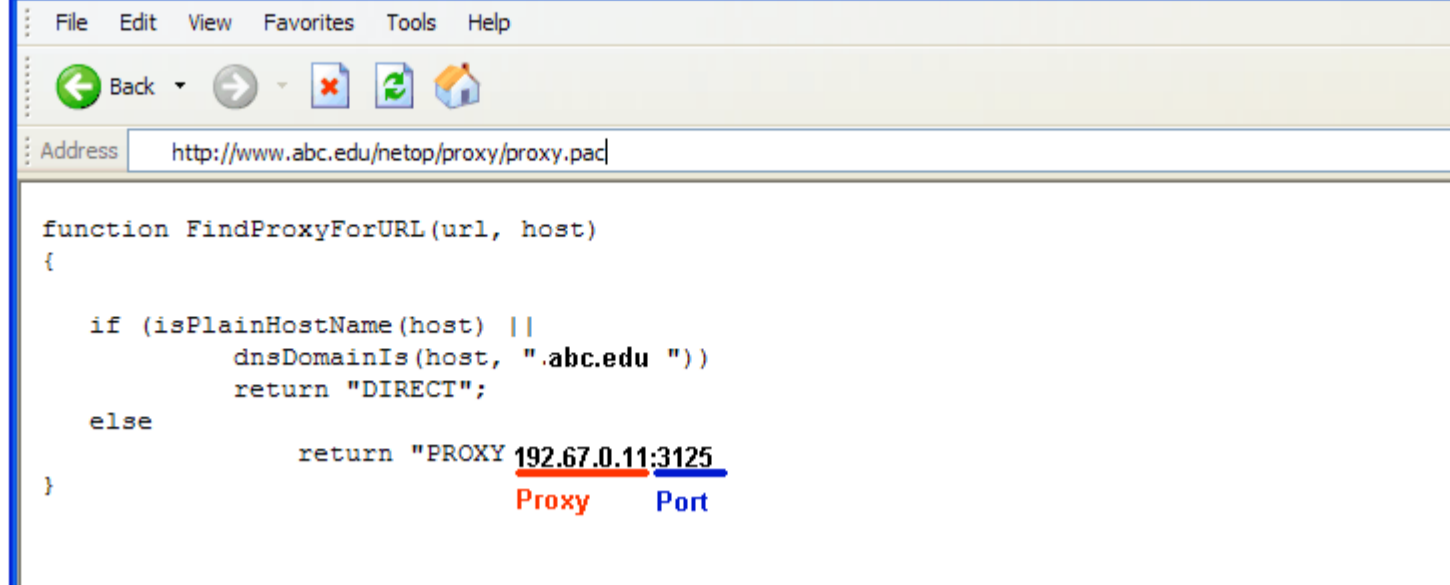


HTTP Tunnel does not officially support ' Automatic configuration script ' However a work around is possible many times. Further assistance for this configuration can be found in the forums. <http://forums.http-tunnel.com/>

Open Internet Explorer. GoTo: Tools>Internet Options>Connections>Lan Settings. You should see a check mark in: Use automatic configuration script. It should look something like this. (Similar settings can be found in Firefox and Netscape)



Copy the entire line of script from the 'Address' box and paste it into a browser's address bar and hit enter. You should then see something appear in the body of the browser that resembles this:



The Proxy and Port number are divided by a colon (:) Make note or write down those values for use later.

Now open the tunnel client and 'Click' the configure option then put a dot in the ' Specify Proxy ' Then enter the values of Proxy and Port into the appropriate fields and then 'Click' test. If all parameters are correct you should then see the ' Test successful configuration updated' message. You would then use the standard configurations for your programs and applications as laid out in the guides. If your application is not included in the guides visit the forums for configuration assistance.
